AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9 1929 (P L 177) entitled "An act provid-
for and reorganizing the conduct of the executive and adminis-
trative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Depart-
ment thereof and the administrative departments boards com-
missions and officers thereof including the boards of trustees of
State Normal Schools or Teachers Colleges abolishing creating
reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain admin-
istrative departments boards and commissions defining the powers

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

hereby enacts as follows

8 missions shall be organized or reorganized as provided in this act

9 Section 2 The act is amended by adding after section 466 a new
10 section to read

11 Section 467 State Board of Examiners for Boiler Engineers The
12 State Board of Examiners for Boiler Engineers is hereby
13 created and shall consist of the Superintendent of Public In-
14 struction ex officio and five members to be appointed by the Secretary
15 of Labor and Industry The term of office of each member so appointed
16 except as herein otherwise provided shall be five years and until his
17 successor be appointed and Qualified Each member of the board shall
18 be a resident of the Commonwealth and of recognized ability and integrity
19 and shall have a Class I Engineer's License in the Commonwealth and

1 shall be selected by the Secretary of Labor and Industry within thirty
2 days of the effective date of this act or after any vacancy occurs in the
3 membership of the board

4 Any vacancy occurring in the board shall be filled by the secretary
5 for the unexpired term only The original appointment of the members
6 of the board shall be for terms of one two three four and five years
7 respectively

8 Three members of the board shall constitute a quorum and the
9 board shall annually select from its members a chairman and a secretary

10 The members of the board other than the Superintendent of Pub-
11 lic Instruction shall receive travel expenses and fifteen dollars (\$15)
12 per diem when actually engaged in the performance of their duties and
13 the secretary shall receive such compensation as the board shall deter-
14 mine subject to the approval of the Superintendent of Public Instruc-
15 tion

16 Section 3 Section 1310 of the act amended February 2 1956 (P L
17 992) and March 2 1956 (P L 1202) is amended to read

18 Section 1310 Professional Examining Boards The professional
19 examining boards within the Department of Public Instruction shall
20 respectively exercise the rights and powers and perform the duties by

1 law vested in and imposed upon them Provided however That all
2 certificates and official documents of such examining boards shall be
3 issued by the Department of Public Instruction but may be signed by
4 the members of the appropriate board or any of them as determined by
5 such board

6 Subject to the preceding provisions of this section and to any other
7 inconsistent provisions in this act contained

8 The State Board of Medical Examination and Licensure shall
9 continue to exercise the powers and perform the duties by law vested
10 in and imposed upon the said board and the Bureau of Medical Exam-
11 ination and Licensure in the Department of Public Instruction

12 The State Board of Pharmacy shall continue to exercise the powers
13 and perform the duties by law vested in and imposed upon the said board

14 The State Dental Council and Examining Board shall continue to
15 exercise the powers and perform the duties by law vested in and imposed
16 upon the said board the State Dental Council and the Board of Dental
17 Examiners for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

18 The State Board of Optometrical Examiners shall continue to ex-
19 ercise the powers and perform the duties by law vested in and imposed

1 upon the said board and the Board of Optometrical Education Exami-
2 nation and Licensure

3 The State Board of Osteopathic Examiners shall continue to
4 exercise the powers and perform the duties by law vested in and im-
5 posed upon the said board and the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners
6 of Pennsylvania

7 The State Board of Nurse Examiners shall continue to exercise
8 the powers and perform the duties by law vested in and imposed upon
9 the said board and the State Board of Examiners for Registration of
10 Nurses

11 The State Board of Barber Examiners shall exercise the powers and
12 perform the duties by law vested in and imposed upon the said board

13 The State Board of Cosmetology shall exercise the powers and per-
14 form the duties by law vested in and imposed upon the said board

15 The State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners shall continue
16 to exercise the powers and perform the duties by law vested in and
17 imposed upon the said board

18 The State Board of Examination of Public Accountants shall con-
19 tinue to exercise the powers and perform the duties by law vested in
20 and imposed upon the said board

1 The State Board of Examiners of Architects shall continue to ex-
2 ercise the powers and perform the duties by law vested in and imposed
3 upon the said board

4 The State Registration Board for Professional Engineers shall
5 continue to exercise the powers and perform the duties by law vested
6 in and imposed upon the said board

7 The State Board of Chiropractic Examiners shall continue to
8 exercise the powers and perform the duties by law vested in and imposed
9 upon the said board

10 The State Board of Chiropody Examiners shall continue to exercise
11 the powers and perform the duties by law vested in and imposed upon
12 the licensing board

13 The State Board of Examiners for Boiler Engineers shall continue
14 to exercise the powers and perform the duties by law vested in and
15 imposed upon said board

16 Section 4 This act shall take effect immediately
