AN ACT

Amending the act of April 14 1834 (P L 333) entitled "An act relative to the organization of the Courts of Justice" requiring certain jurors excused in one term of court to be enrolled for jury duty at the next term of court

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 The act of April 14 1834 (P L. 333) entitled "An act
2 relative to the organization of the Courts of Justice" is amended by
3 adding after section 135 a new section to read

4 Section 135.1 All persons who are excused from jury duty in one
5 term of court shall be automatically enrolled for jury services at the
6 next term of court unless the reason for being excused is for reasons
7 of health based on a doctor's certificate
