AN ACT

Amending the act of June 24 1939 (P L 872) entitled "An act to consolidate amend and revise the penal laws of the Commonwealth" prohibiting the coloring or dyeing of chickens ducks or rabbits and the sale of colored or dyed chickens ducks or rabbits

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 The act of June 24 1939 (P L 872) known as "The
2 Penal Code" is amended by adding after section 941 a new section
3 to read

4 Section 941.1 Coloring Chickens Ducks and Rabbits for Sale Who-
5 ever colors or dyes any chicken duck or rabbit or offers for sale or sells
6 any colored or dyed chicken duck or rabbit shall upon summary con-
7 viction thereof be sentenced to pay a fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25)
8 and costs of prosecution and in default of the payment of said fine and
9 costs to undergo imprisonment not exceeding thirty (30) days
