AN ACT

Amending the act of August 9 1955 (P L 323) entitled "An act relating to counties of the third fourth fifth sixth seventh and eighth classes amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto" fixing the time for the annual report by the county auditors to the court of common pleas

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 Subsection (a) of section 1721 act of August 9 1955
- 2 (P L 323) known as "The County Code" amended February 10 1956
- 3 (P L 1039) is amended to read

1 Section 1721 Audit of Accounts by Auditors Report to Common
2 Pleas Publications Financial Report to Department of Internal Affairs
3 (a) The auditors shall audit settle and adjust the accounts of all county
4 officers of the county and make an annual report thereof on or before
5 the [first Monday of] fifteenth day of April to the court of common
6 pleas unless upon due cause shown the court shall grant an extension
7 of time therefor Said report shall be in detail showing distinctly and
8 separately all receipts and expenditures of the several offices and all
9 debts and accounts due and the amount raised from each source of
10 revenue and the expenditures in detail and classified by reference to
11 the object thereof together with a full statement of the financial condi-
12 tions of the county and a statement of the balance due from or to such
13 county officers
