AN ACT

Amending the act of July 8 1957 (P L 579) entitled "An act establishing minimum compensation and increments for members of the faculty and administration of the Thaddeus Stevens Trade School and imposing duties on the Board of Trustees of such school and the Superintendent of Public Instruction" changing the salaries and increments of teachers and supervisors and providing for payment on a monthly basis

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Section 1 act of July 8 1957 (P L 579) entitled "An

6 Section 1 Compensation of each member of the faculty of the
7 Thaddeus Stevens Trade School shall be payable for twelve months
8 in equal monthly or semi-monthly installments [during the regular
9 school term or year of ten months] for each school year Salaries beyond
10 the regular school day [or school term] shall be paid on a prorata basis

11 Section 2 Section 2 of the act amended December 8 1959 (P L
12 1721) is amended to read

13 Section 2 Each person heretofore or hereafter appointed to a posi-
14 tion as a member of the faculty of the Thaddeus Stevens Trade School
15 shall receive the following minimum salaries and yearly increments for
16 services rendered during the [regular school term] fiscal school year
17 or years

18 (1) Teachers holding a standard or college certificate valid for the
19 subjects or grades in which the teacher is giving instruction minimum

1 annual salary for the school year 1958-1959 three thousand dollars
2 (\$3,000) for the school year 1959-1960 three thousand six hundred dol-
3 lars (\$3,600) for the school year 1961-1962 minimum monthly salary
4 of three hundred thirty-three dollars (\$333) minimum annual service
5 increment [two hundred dollars (\$200)] at the rate of nineteen dollars
6 (\$19) per month minimum number of annual service increments twelve

7 (2) Teachers holding a master's degree and who also hold a college
8 certificate valid for the subjects or grades in which the teacher is
9 giving instruction minimum annual salary for the school year 1958-
10 1959 three thousand six hundred dollars (\$3,600) for the school year
11 1959-1960 four thousand two hundred dollars (\$4,200) for the school
12 year 1961-1962 minimum monthly salary of three hundred eighty-one
13 dollars (\$381) minimum annual service increment [two hundred dol-
14 lars (\$200) at the rate of nineteen dollars (\$19) per month minimum
15 number of annual service increments twelve

16 (3) Teachers of applied arts and vocational subjects who hold a
17 standard certificate shall be entitled to the same minimum salary and
18 increments as teachers who hold a college certificate

19 (4) Teachers of applied arts and vocational subjects who hold a
20 standard or college certificate and have earned an additional thirty

1 semester hours of credit in professional education in the teaching field
2 in which said teacher is engaged or related thereto shall be entitled
3 to the same minimum salary and increments as teachers holding a
4 master's degree

5 (5) The maximum salary required to be paid under the provisions
6 of this section shall not exceed the minimum annual salary plus the
7 sum of the total number of increments for the class

8 (6) Supervisors who devote one-half or more of their time to super-
9 vision of instruction holding a standard or college certificate for the
10 school year 1958-1959 minimum annual salary three thousand eight
11 hundred dollars (\$3,800) for the school year 1959-1960 four thousand
12 four hundred dollars (\$4,400) for the school year 1960-1961 four
13 thousand six hundred dollars (\$4,600) for the school year 1961-1962
14 minimum monthly salary of four hundred twenty-six dollars (\$426)
15 minimum annual service increment [two hundred dollars (\$200)] at
16 the rate of nineteen dollars (\$19) per month minimum number of annual
17 service increments seven

18 (7) Supervisors who devote one-half or more of their time to super-
19 vision of instruction holding a master's degree minimum annual salary
20 for the school year 1958-1959 four thousand dollars (\$4,000) for the

1 school year 1959-1960 four thousand six hundred dollars (\$4,600) for
2 the school year 1960-1961 four thousand eight hundred dollars (\$4,800)
3 for the school year 1961-1962 minimum monthly salary of four hun-
4 dred forty-four dollars (\$444) minimum annual service increment [two
5 hundred dollars (\$200)] at the rate of nineteen dollars (\$19) per
6 month minimum number of annual service increments eight

7 Notwithstanding any other provisions of this act each teacher and
8 supervisor whose salary and increments are fixed by this act and who
9 is a member of the faculty or administration of the Thaddeus Stevens
10 Trade School on the effective date of this act shall be granted in addi-
11 tion to the salary and increments otherwise prescribed by this act for
12 the school years 1959-1960 and 1960-1961 added compensation of two
13 hundred dollars (\$200) for each of said school years as a cost of living
14 increase in compensation

15 Section 3 This act shall take effect immediately
