AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9 1929 (P. L. 177) entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments boards commissions and officers thereof including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools or Teachers Colleges abolishing creating reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative departments boards and commissions defining the

powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers and of the several administrative departments boards commissions and officers fixing the salaries of the Governor Lieutenant Governor and certain other executive and administrative officers providing for the appointment of certain administrative officers and of all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain departments boards and commissions and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments boards and commissions shall be determined” requiring the Department of Health to develop a program for the study prevention treatment and control of alcoholism narcotic addiction and compulsive gambling providing for the maintenance of a certain institution for said purposes and making an appropriation

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

Section 2116 Institute for Alcoholism Narcotic Addiction and

Compulsive Gambling The Department of Health shall have the power
and its duty shall be

(1) To develop a comprehensive program for the study prevention
treatment and control of alcoholism narcotic addiction and compulsive
gambling

(2) To maintain an institution for the treatment and assistance
of persons afflicted with alcoholism narcotic addiction and compulsive
gambling to be known as the Institute for Alcoholism Narcotic Addic-
tion and Compulsive Gambling which institution shall be located in
facilities presently being utilized for that purpose in the city of Phila-
delphia such institute to be under the direct supervision and control
of the Secretary of Health and not subject to any intervening bureaus
or similar departmental agencies
