AN ACT

Requiring the State Treasurer and other State officials to deduct the tax imposed by any city of the second class upon salaries wages and other compensation paid to officers and employes of the Commonwealth domiciled or performing services within that city and to make a return and remit the tax so deducted to the treasurer of such city

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 It shall be the duty of the State Treasurer or other
2 appropriate State official at the time of payment of the salary wage or
3 other compensation to any officer or employe of the Commonwealth
4 of Pennsylvania with the exception of elected officials domiciled or
5 rendering services within any city of the second class to deduct any tax
6 imposed by such city on the salary wage or other compensation paid
7 by the Commonwealth to any officer or employe thereof The State
8 Treasurer or other appropriate State official shall on or before the
9 last day of April 1961 make a return on a form furnished by or obtain-
10 able from the treasurer of such city and remit to the treasurer the
11 amount of tax so deducted for the three month period ending on the
12 last day of the month preceding

13 Section 2 This act shall take effect immediately
