AN ACT

Requiring funeral directors to notify the voters registration commission upon the burial of any person over twenty-one years of age and providing penalties

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 Upon the burial of any person over the age of twenty-
- 2 one years the funeral director in charge of the burial shall within
- 3 ten days notify the voters registration commission of the county where-

4 tenced to pay a fine of fifty dollars (\$50) or undergo imprisonment for
5 a period not exceeding ten days
