AN ACT

Amending the act of April 29 1959 (P L 58) entitled "An act consolidating and revising the Vehicle Code the Tractor Code the Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility Act and other acts relating to the ownership possession and use of vehicles and tractors" removing provisions appropriating a portion of the fee received from learners' permits to the Department of Public Instruction for carrying out a standardized program of teaching safe driving of motor vehicles

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Section 717 act of April 29 1959 (P L 58) known as
2 "The Vehicle Code" amended November 21 1959 (P L 1577) is amended
3 to read

4 Section 717 Operators' Licenses Duplicate Registration or Opera-
5 tor's License Card

6 (a) The fee for issuing an operator's license to a person unable
7 to produce satisfactory proof of having held a Pennsylvania operator's
8 license during any one of the three (3) years preceding application shall
9 be four dollars (\$4.00) which fee shall entitle the applicant for such
10 license to receive a learner's permit valid for ninety (90) days from date
11 of issue and if the examination shall have been passed during the ninety-
12 day period an operator's license for the current period not to exceed
13 one (1) year from date of learner's permit or until the occurrence of
14 the month of birth of the operator at the discretion of the secretary

15 (b) The fee for renewal of an operator's license shall be two dollars
16 (\$2.00) per year

17 (c) The fee for a duplicate operator's license card or duplicate
18 registration card shall be fifty cents (50c)

1 [(d) As much of the fee received for each learner's permit as may
2 be necessary but not more than two dollars (\$2.00) is hereby appropri-
3 ated to the Department of Public Instruction for the purpose of paying
4 authorized expenses incurred by that department in connection with
5 carrying out a standardized program of teaching of safe driving of motor
6 vehicles in the public schools and making authorized payments to school
7 districts complying with such standardized program Such moneys shall
8 be paid out of the Motor License Fund upon the warrant of the Auditor
9 General drawn after requisition by the Department of Public Instruc-
10 tion]

11 (e) The fee for renewal of the initial operator's license for the two
12 (2) year license period may be prorated by the secretary

13 Section 2 This act shall take effect June 1 1961
