AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10 1949 (P L 30) entitled "An act relating to the public school system including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto" requiring school districts to provide suitable space stenographic services and other office facilities to county superintendents

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Section 1039 act of March 10 1949 (P L 30) known as
2 the "Public School Code of 1949" is repealed

3 Section 2 Section 1040 of the act is amended to read

4 Section 1040 [Telephone Typewriter and Stenographer] Suitable
5 Space Stenographic Services and Office Facilities Furnished by [County]
6 School Districts In each county the county superintendent of schools
7 [may] shall be provided at the expense of the [county with a tele-
8 phone a typewriter and a stenographer In counties having more than
9 three hundred (300) teachers in the public schools the stenographer
10 may be employed by the year In counties having less than three hun-
11 dred (300) teachers in the public schools the stenographer shall be
12 employed for at least two days of each week or the equivalent of such
13 time during the year] Various school districts whose directors vote or
14 are eligible to vote in electing the county superintendent of schools
15 with telephone service typewriters stenographers equipment and mate-
16 rials used in the performance of the duties of the county superintendent
17 of schools in connection with pupils or teachers and with such office
18 equipment facilities and suitable space as shall be determined by the
19 county superintendent to be necessary in order to carry out the func-
20 tions of his office and which are approved by the school districts pro-

1 viding such equipment facilities and space The amount paid by the
2 various school districts shall be apportioned by the county superintendent
3 of schools among the school districts according to their population as
4 determined by the latest official United States census

5 The stenographer [may] or stenographers shall be chosen by the
6 county superintendent and the compensation shall be fixed by the county
7 superintendent [and county commissioners] subject to approval by a
8 majority of the school directors of the school districts providing the
9 stenographer or stenographers and shall be paid out of the [county
10 treasury] funds of the school districts

11 Section 3 Section 1041 of the act is repealed

12 Section 4 The act of May 11 1949 (P L 1106) entitled "An act
13 requiring the county commissioners to provide at the expense of the
14 county telephone service typewriters stenographers office space materials
15 and other equipment for the use of the county superintendent of schools"
16 is repealed

17 Section 5 This act shall take effect immediately
