## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 30 1905 (P L 78) entitled "An act to further define the duties and powers of the State Live Stock Sanitary Board to prevent the spread of dangerous contagious or infectious diseases among domestic animals to require reports to be made of the existence of such diseases to limit appraisements and payments for animals that it may be necessary to destroy to prevent the spread of disease to protect milk supplies from contamination to authorize cooperation with local boards of health

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows
