AN ACT

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Section 3 act of April 18 1929 (P. L. 609) entitled "An

11 Section 3 For the purpose of locating the burial places of persons
12 who have served in the military or naval service or other branches of

1 the combative forces of the United States during any war in which
2 the United States was engaged the Grand Army of the Republic the
3 United Spanish War Veterans the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the
4 United States the American Legion the Italian American [World]
5 War Veterans of the United States Incorporated [Department of Penn-
6 sylvania] and the Disabled American Veterans of the World War through
7 their local camps posts and branches in this State are authorized without
8 expense to the county to collect the required data and prepare and file
9 with the county commissioners or the city commissoiners of cities of
10 the first class certificates embodying the information provided for in
11 section one hereof
