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**AN ACT**

Amending the act of August 9 1955 (P L 323) entitled "An act relating to counties of the third fourth fifth sixth seventh and eighth classes amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto" ~~removing~~ **INCREASING** the limitation on appropriations which may be made for agricultural extension work

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

4 Section 1936 Agricultural Extension Work The board of com-  
5 missioners may appropriate a sum {not to exceed [eighteen thousand  
6 dollars (\$18,000)] to be determined by the commissioners TWENTY-  
7 TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$22,000) annually for agricultural  
8 extension work in cooperation with the Pennsylvania State University  
9 in encouraging improved methods of farm management and home  
10 economics and giving practical instruction and demonstrations in  
11 agriculture for the purpose of improving and developing the agricultural  
12 resources of the county The money so appropriated shall be expended  
13 according to rules and regulations prescribed or approved by the board  
14 of commissioners The board of commissioners may also where practicable  
15 and desirable provide offices in the county court house for headquarters  
16 for such cooperative work
