

CHAPTER VII.

An ACT to erect Half-moon and Patton townships, in the county of Centre, into a new election district.

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this act, the townships of Half-moon and Patton, in the county of Centre, shall be a separate election district; and the electors thereof shall hold their general elections at the house now occupied by Abraham Elder, in Half-moon township.

An ACT for erecting two election districts in the county of Montgomery.

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly

pied by David Dewees, in the township of Pro-
vidence aforesaid.*

thority aforesaid, That the township of Upper-
Hanover, Marlborough, Upper-Salford and
Franconia, in the county aforesaid, shall be a
separate election district, to be called the eighth
district; and the electors thereof shall hold their
general elections at the house now occupied by
John Scheid, in Summeny town, in Marlbo-
rough township aforesaid.*
