CHAPTER XCV.

An ACT altering the place of holding the general election in the district composed of Plumb and part of Versailles township, in Allegheny county.

Betion 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the auplace of hold-thority of the same, That from and after the ing general elections in the passing of this act, the electors of the district composed of Plumb township, and that part of Versailles township that lies north of the state of Versailles township that lies north of the state road in Allegheny county, shall hold their getownship, Allegheny county, at the house now occupied by John Little, on the Frankstown state road in Plumb township, any former law or laws tow the contrary notwithstanding.
