CHAPTER XCVIII.

An ACT to erect Milford township, in the county of Somerset, into a separate election district.

Section 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the of Milford, passing of this act, the township of Milford, county, to be in Somerset county, shall be a separate elections, and elections to be held their general elections at the house now occutate the house pied by John Gephart in Milford township of John Geparts.

CHAPTER XCIX.
