Section 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority

The time for thority of the same, That a further time of manent bridge five years, from and after the time heretofore over the river allowed by law, be and the same is hereby granted and allowed to the president, directors and company for erecting a permanent tended for five bridge over the river Schuylkill, at or near the city of Philadelphia, incorporated on the twenty-seventh day of February, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-eight, by the name and stile of "The president, directors and "company, for erecting a permanent bridge "over the river Schuylkill, at or near the city "of Philadelphia," to complete the erection of the said bridge: And if the said company do not complete the same within the term heretofore allowed by law, and the additional term herein granted, it shall and may be lawful for the legislature of this commonwealth, to resume all and singular, the rights, liberties and privileges granted to the said company, by virtue of an act, entitled "An Act, to au-"thorise the Governor of this commonwealth, "to incorporate a company for erecting a "permanent bridge over the river Schuyl-"kill, at or near the city of Philadelphia."
