CHAPTER CXXIV.

An ACT to erect a certain election district in the county of Wayne.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is bereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the township of Buck. Saint Tammany district, ingham, Demascus and that part of Lackawaxen Wayne county township, lying north of Lacakawaxen creek, erected, and east of the Barrens in said township, are hereby erected into a separate election district, to be called Saint Tammany district, and the where elections at the house now occupied by Reuben held. Skinner, in said county.
