That every such dam be so constructed with proper slope a proper slope or slopes, erected in the most is made, &c. convenient part thereof, so that rafts may not be obstructed in passing down the said waters; which slope shall be at least thirty feet dimentions of wide, and be one foot lower than the other parts of such dam, the surface whereof shall be made of wood or other materials well compacted together, so that none of the water may be lost in passing down the same, and for every foot such slope shall be in heighth it shall extend fifteen feet down the stream.
