

CHAPTER CII.

An ACT making compensation to Brigade-Inspectors for furnishing Blank Forms.

Section I. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this act, each brigade-inspector shall, in full compensation for furnishing all such necessary blank forms as are prescribed in the tenth section of the militia law, passed the sixth day of April one thousand eight hundred and two, receive yearly the sum of ten dollars for each regiment in his brigade, out of the militia fund, on warrants drawn by the Governor.

10 dollars for each regiment allowed to brigade inspectors as a compensation for furnishing blank forms.
