CHAPTER CCIII.

An ACT erecting certain Election Districts, and making alterations in other Districts already erected.

Section. 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this act, the electors residing within the third election District, composed of the townships of Tinicum, Nockamixon, and Derham, in the county of Bucks, shall hold their general elections at the house now occupied by Michael Ott, in the township of Nockamixon aforesaid, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.
