CHAPTER CX.

A SUPPLEMENT to and repealing part of an act, entitled " An act to encourage the patenting of lands and for other purposes."

SECTION I. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That so much of the second section of the act to which this is a supplement, passed the fourth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and five, as requires the governor to apply the one half of the purchase money and interest received or that may be paid into the treasury for lands, to the purchase of bank stock, be and the same is hereby repealed so far as is applied to that part of the monies not appropriated in stock, and until the first day of September next, from and after which day the said act shall be and continue in full force and effect.*

Certain parts of the act of April 4, 1805 repealed for a time.

SECT. II. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the provisions contained in the act entitled, " An act abolishing the offices of Receiver General and Master of the Rolls, and transferring the duties therein performed to other offices, and for other purposes," passed March the twenty-ninth, one thousand eight hundred and nine, shall not be understood in any manner to lessen, alter or affect the payment of the surveying fees directed to be paid by Connecticut settlers, by the fifth section of the act entitled " An act for offering compensation to the Pennsylvania claimants of certain lands within the seventeen townships in the county of Luzerne, and for other purposes therein mentioned," passed April fourth, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine.*

The act abolishing the office of receiver-general, &c. not to affect the payment of certain fees.
