Resolved, That the governor be requested to transmit a copy of the foregoing preamble and resolution to each of the senators and representatives of this state in Congress, and to the executive of each state in the union, with a request that the same be laid before the legislature thereof. CHAPTER VI.

RESOLVED, *by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, That* it shall be the duty of the secretary of the commonwealth, to forward to the prothonotaries of the several counties in this state, a copy of the laws passed during the present session, to each of the members now representing such counties in the legislature, with the names of such members written on the title page of their copies respectively; and it shall be the duty of the prothonotaries to deliver said copies to such members as soon as they shall be applied for, after such prothonotary has received the same: *Provided always,* That such members shall not be entitled to receive another copy at the next session of the legislature. Copies of the laws to be sent to the members, &c. Name of each member to be written in the title page. Duty of the prothonotaries. Provide.
