CHAPTER LII.

An ACT authorizing the purchase and distribution of a certain number of copies of Bache's Manual.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is bereby enacted by the authority of the same. That the governor is hereby authorized and required to subscribe on behalf of this commonwealth for fifteen hundred copies of "The Manual of a Pennsylvania Justice of the peace," published by Richard Bache, junior; Provided, the price thereof shall not exceed one dollar and fifty cents for each copy, to be delivered into the secretary's office and to be paid for on delivery, on a warrant drawn on the treasurer of this commonwealth.

1500 copies of the manual "of a Pennsylvania Justice of the peace to be sub-scribed for.

Proviso.

Prothonotariesto transmit to the secretary of the commonwealth a list of the acting aldermen and justices of the peace.

among members of the legislature

SECT. II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the prothonotaries of the city and counties of this commonwealth are hereby required, as soon as conveniently may be, to transmit to the secretary of this commonwealth, a list of all the acting aldermen and justices in the said city and counties respectively, and the said secretary is hereby directed to deliver to each member of the senate and house of representatives one copy, and to transmit to the said prothonotaries of the city and tribute copies of counties of this commonwealth, with the laws of this session, the said manual one converge continuous and converge conve one copy for each acting alderman or justice in the said city and And the prothonotaries aforesaid are hereby required to deliver one copy to each of the said aldermen or justices, and take a receipt therefor, and on the resignation, removal out of the district, or death of any of the said aldermen or justices, the said justice or alderman, or their executors or administrators, shall forthwith return said copy to the said prothonotary or his successor in office, who shall deliver the same to the next justice that may be appointed in such district.
