

CHAPTER C.

An ACT supplementary to an act, relative to the patenting of lands.

SECT. I. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That

all the provisions of the act, entitled, "An act relating to the patenting of lands;" passed the twenty-first day of February, one thousand eight hundred and ten, shall be, and the same hereby are continued until the first day of January, in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirteen, and no longer: Provided nevertheless, That nothing herein contained shall be construed, or so understood as to entitle any person or persons, or corporate bodies, executors or administrators, on behalf of each minor, to the benefits of this act, for any greater quantity than five hundred acres of land held by him, her or them, in his, her or their own right.

CHAPTER CI.

An ACT extending the power of the trustees of the Greensburgh academy.

SECT. I. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That it shall and may be lawful for the trustees of the Greensburgh academy to erect buildings for the use of said institution, either within the limits of the borough of Greensburgh, or in the vicinity thereof as they, or a majority of them may think proper, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

Trustees of the Greensburgh academy authorized to fix a site and erect buildings.
