CHAPTER CXII.

An ACT for the relief of Henry Beardt.

SECT. I. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the state treasurer be, and he is hereby directed to pay unto Henry Beardt or to his order the sum of forty dollars, immediately after the passing of this act, and an annuity of forty dollars for life, payable half yearly out of any monies in the treasury not otherwise by law appropriated. 40 dollars, and an annuity of like amount granted to Henry Beardt.

CHAPTER CXIII.

An ACT for the further establishment and regulation of election districts.

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passing of this act, Ross township in the county of Allegheny, shall be erected into a separate election district, and the electors thereof shall hold their general elections at the house now occupied by Samuel Allen in said township. Ross township in Allegheny county made an election district.

SECT. II. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That from and after the passing of this act, Pine township in Allegheny county, shall be erected into a separate election district, and the electors thereof shall hold their general elections at the house now occupied by William Cochrane in said township.
