receive benefit from the same, if such buildings are or shall be

insured in any other office.

SECT. XXIV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid Power of re-That if at any time it shall appear to the legislature that the retained, charter privileges hereby granted, are injurious to the public welfare, the power thereof to repeal this act shall not on any conditions be denied or impaired, but such repeal shall not Shall not affect affect any engagements, to which said company may have be-any contract encome a party previously thereto; and that the said company shall have a reasonable time to bring their accounts to a final settlement and termination.

CHAPTER CXXXIX.

A SUPPLEMENT to the act, entitled, " An act to erect parts of Lycoming, Huntingdon, and Somerset counties, into separate county districts."

WHEREAS it appears that much difficulty has arisen on account of the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement not having been carried into effect, owing to the small sum allowed to the commissioners for running and marking the boundary lines, as a great part thereof has to be run through an uninhabited part of the county and over extreme bad ground; for these reasons the boundaries of the county have not been ascertained; for remedy thereof,

SECT. 1. B. it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Additional comcommissioners appointed by the act to which this is a supple- penation allowed to certain ment to run and mark the boundary lines of Cambria county, commissioners. shall in addition to the sum allowed them by the seventh section of the act to which this is a supplement, receive the sum of seventy-five cents for every mile so run and marked.
