CHAPTER LXXXVII.

An ACT for the relief of the Lutheran and Calvinist congregations of Row's Church, in Penn township, Northumberland county.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the elders of the Lutheran and Calvinist congregations, belonging to the church, in the township of Penn, in the county of Northumberland, commonly called Row's church, or a majority of them, for the time being, whether they are known in law as such or not, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, to sell and convey in fee simple, or for a lesser estate, not exceeding one half of the land or tract belonging to Row's church congregations, on which said tract of land the church aforesaid now stands, and to apply the money arising from the sale, in building a new church, or repairing the old, in such manner as the elders for the time being, of both the congregations, or a majority of them, may direct.

Elders of the Lutheran and Calvinist congregations, Penn township, Northumberland county, authorized to sell and convey one half of a tract of land belonging to Row's church congregation. Proceeds of sale to be appropriated to build a new or repair the old one.

CHAPTER LXXXVIII.

An ACT granting a sum of money to the trustees of Bedford Academy, in the county of Bedford.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the state treasurer be authorized and required, to pay to the trustees of the Bedford Academy, the sum of two thousand dol.

lars, out of any money in the treasury of this commonwealth, to be applied in finishing the building which has been erected by said trustees; also for the purpose of purchasing the necessary mathematical, geographical, and philosophical apparatus, for the use of said academy.

SECT. II. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That there shall be admitted into said academy any number of poor children who may at any time be offered, in order to be taught gratis: *Provided,* the number so admitted and taught, shall at no time be greater than six.

SECT. III. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the accounts respecting said academy, shall be annually presented by the trustees thereof, to the auditors of Bedford county, to be examined and reported by them in the same manner that the public accounts of the county of Bedford from time to time are directed to be audited by the laws of this commonwealth.

SECT. IV. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That an act incorporating the Bedford academy, and granting a sum of money thereto, passed the twentieth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and ten, be and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER LXXXIX.

WHEREAS the trustees of the German Calvinist congregation of Bethel Church, in Albany township, in Berks county, and of the Calvinist congregation of Jacob's church, and of the Calvinist congregation of Ebethnezer church, in Lynn township, in Northampton county, by their petition to the general assembly, have represented that Edmund Physick, agent for John Penn, by deed, dated the seventeenth day of October, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine, did grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Ferdinand Ritter, John Smith, and Jacob Oswald, trustees of the congregations afore-
