

CHAPTER CXXVII.

An ACT granting relief to John Brown, a wounded soldier.

BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the state-treasurer pay to John Brown, or order, of York county, a wounded soldier of the late revolutionary war, the sum of forty dollars, immediately after the passing of this act.

CHAPTER CXXVIII.

An ACT for the relief of Peter M^rBride, an old wounded soldier.

BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the state-treasurer be and he is hereby directed to pay unto Peter M^rBride, or order, the sum of forty dollars immediately after the passing of this act, and that an annuity of forty dollars be granted for the use of Peter M^rBride for life, to be paid to Jacob Blocher, of Somerset county, his executor or executors, administrator or administrators, or his or their lawful attorney, to commence the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and twelve, and to be paid half yearly, which annuity shall be expended in providing clothing and diet for the said Peter M^rBride, and it shall be, and is hereby made the duty of the said Jacob Blocher, his executors or administrators, to make an annual return to the orphans' court, of Somerset county, on oath or affirmation, how and in what manner he or they have executed the trust in him or them confided by this act, and it shall be the duty of the clerk of said court to file said account without fee or reward.

§40 granted to Peter M^rBride. And an annuity of like amount. to be paid to Jacob Blocher. When to commence. How to be expended. Return to be made to the orphans' court, &c.
