

CHAPTER CXC.

A SUPPLEMENT to the act, entitled "An act to empower William Pennell, guardian of Matthias Richard Sayres, and Edward Smith Sayres, to sell and convey real estate belonging to the said minors."

His duty.

*SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Samuel Anderson of the county of Delaware, the present guardian of Matthias Richard Sayres, and Edward Smith Sayres, minors, be, and he is hereby authorized to sell and convey all the right, title, and interest of the said minors, in and to a certain real estate situate in the township of Lower Chichester, in said county in the same manner, and subject to the like surety and restrictions, as William Pennell, the former guardian, was authorized to sell the same, by virtue of the act to which this is supplementary.*

CHAPTER CXCI.

An ACT to facilitate the improving the great road, leading from Green's mill, in Dauphin county, over Peter's mountain, to Sunbury, in Northumberland county.

Commissioners of Dauphin to view a certain road.

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the commissioners of Dauphin county, or a majority of them, be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to view that part of the road from the house of John Ayres, at the south foot of Peter's mountain, thence over and across the same to the north foot of said mountain, to the house of Robert McCall.*

And contract with persons to improve the same.

SECT. II. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That it shall be the duty of the commissioners of Dauphin county, or a majority of them, on or before the first day of May next, to contract with one or more person or persons, to open and make, in whole or in part, or to improve the said road as the case may require, on the south side of Peter's mountain, up to the summit level, and with one or more person or persons, to open and make, and improve the road as aforesaid, from the summit level to the north foot of said mountain, to open in whole or in part, make or cause to be made, a good and complete road for waggons of burden and stages to travel on the*
