

net, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That it shall and may be lawful for the sheriff of Schuylkill county, to receive all and every person who may now be confined in the jail of Berks county, in consequence of any legal process issued by proper authority from Schuylkill county, and convey him, her or them, to the jail of Schuylkill county, and to keep him, her or them in close custody, until they or either of them, shall be discharged by due course of law, as well as all other persons who may be in his custody by virtue of legal process issued by proper authority, in the county of Schuylkill.

Sheriff of Schuylkill county authorized to receive prisoners now confined in Berks county.

SECT. II. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the second, third and fourth sections of the act, entitled, "A further supplement to the act, entitled, "An act for erecting part of Berks and Northampton counties into a separate county," be, and the same are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER XXXIV.

An ACT making an appropriation for the employment of an additional clerk in the office of the secretary of the commonwealth.

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives, of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the sum of five hundred dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated for the employment of one additional clerk for one year, in the office of the secretary of the commonwealth.
