## CHAPTER XCIV.

An ACT granting a tract of donation land, and a gratuity, to Henry Young.

SECT. I. BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in gene al assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Tracrof donathe officers of the land office be, and they are hereby directed to Henry Young. to draw and patent to Henry Young, of Washington county, Maryland, a tract of donation land, containing two hundred acres; and the state treasurer is hereby directed to pay to said Henry Young, or order, forty dollars immediately after the passing of this act.
