CHAPTER XCIX.

An ACT authorizing the governor of this commonwealth to subscribe to a loan opened by the government of the United States.

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the governor be and he is hereby required to subscribe to the loan of sixteen millions of dollars, authorized to be subscribed by an act passed by the congress of the United States, on the eighth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and thirteen, on behalf of this commonwealth, one million dollars which shall be paid agreeably to the terms thereof, on warrants drawn by him on the treasury of this state.

Governor directed to subscribe 1,000,000 dollars to U. S. loan.

SECT. II. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That it shall be the duty of the governor, and he is hereby authorized to negotiate a loan or loans with any of the incorporated banks, other bodies politic or individuals within this commonwealth, for such sum or sums, at an interest not exceeding six per centum per annum, as may be necessary for enabling him to pay the amount subscribed by him to the loan of the United States, and the faith of this commonwealth is

hereby pledged for the reimbursement of the said loan or loans within six years, and in such instalments as may be agreed on by the parties.

SECT. III. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the governor be and he is hereby directed to lay before the legislature within the first week of the next session, a report of his proceedings under this act.

CHAPTER C.

An ACT for the relief of Enoch Morgan, late a pay-master in the revolutionary war.

Gratuity of 80

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the state treasurer be, and he is hereby directed to pay to Enoch Morgan, or order, eighty dollars immediately after the passing of this act, in full for services rendered in the revolutionary war.

CHAPTER CI.

An ACT granting a tract of donation land to the trustees of Butler academy, in the county of Butler.

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the officers of the land office be, and they are hereby authorized and required to draw and patent, without fees, for a tract of undrawn donation land in the county of Butler, to the trustees of Butler academy, and it shall be the duty of the said trustees to dispose of the same to the best advantage,
