CHAPTER C.

An ACT for the relief of Enoch Morgan, late a pay-master in the revolutionary war.

Gratuity of 80 dollars to Enoch Morgan.

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the state treasurer be, and he is hereby directed to pay to Enoch Morgan, or order, eighty dollars immediately after the passing of this act, in full for services rendered in the revolutionary war.

CHAPTER CI.

An ACT granting a tract of donation land to the trustees of Butler academy, in the county of Butler.

Tract of donation land granted to the trustees of Butler county for the use of Butler academy.

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the officers of the land office be, and they are hereby authorized and required to draw and patent, without fees, for a tract of undrawn donation land in the county of Butler, to the trustees of Butler academy, and it shall be the duty of the said trustees to dispose of the same to the best advantage,

either by sale, lease or otherwise, and to apply the proceeds thereof to the benefit of said institution.

SECT. II. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That it shall be the duty of the said trustees to lay a detailed statement of the manner, in which this appropriation has been expended, before the auditors of the county of Butler, whose duty it shall be to settle, adjust and publish the same, as public accounts of commissioners are settled, adjusted and published.

CHAPTER CIII.

An ACT authorizing the administrators of the estate of Casper Wight, to convey a tract of land in Antis township, Huntingdon county.

WHEREAS it has been represented to the legislature by the petition of John Barlet that he purchased in partnership with Casper Wight, a certain tract of land called Rich Land, containing three hundred and twelve acres, on the waters of little Juniata, in Antis township, Huntingdon county; and whereas, it appears that the title by purchase was conveyed to Casper Wight, who since died intestate, and it further
