Work to be comceed to carry on the said work in three years after the passing three, and come of this act, or shall not within fifteen years after the passing aftern years. of this act. complete the said road according to the true intent and meaning of this act, then and in either of these cases, all and singular the rights, liberties, and franchises hereby granted to the said company, shall revert to this commonwealth.

CHAPTER CV.

A SUPPLEMENT to the act, incorporating a company for making a turnpike road from Middletown to Harrisburg; passed the nineteenth of March, one thousand eight hundred and ten.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the senate and bouse of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is kereby enacted by the authority of the same, That J. Hopkins and James Hopkins of Lancaster, and George Fisher of Harris-pointed commissioners, are hereby appointed additional commissioners, to those tain purposes. mentioned in the first section of the original act, to perform with said first appointed commissioners, the several duties required of them by the said act.

SECT. 11. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That if the company to be incorporated by the original act, Time limited for shall not proceed to carry on the said work in three years afthe commencement and comter the first of May, one thousand eightfundred and thirteen, pletton of a turtipletton of a road, then and in either of these cases, all and singular the rights, liberties and franchises, granted to the said company by the act to which this is a supplement, shall revert to the commonwealth; and the proviso in the third section of said act repealed

act is hereby repealed.
