

the ministers, vestrymen and church wardens of the German Lutheran congregation, in and near the city of Philadelphia, in the state of Pennsylvania, be and they hereby are authorized to sell, dispose of, and convey, ten certain tracts of land or any part or parcel thereof, situate on the heads of the west branch of Lycoming creek, and on the head of Little Pine creek, formerly in Northumberland county, containing five thousand one hundred and seventy-six acres, and one hundred and thirty perches, or thereabouts, and allowance for the best price that can be obtained, and to execute to the purchaser or purchasers thereof a sufficient deed or deeds in fee simple, and invest the monies arising therefrom in some safe or productive stock or funds, or at interest on mortgage, with private individuals as the same may be most advantageous, and shall apply the dividends or interest arising from the same to the uses and purposes for which the said lands were granted, by an act of general assembly, passed the fourteenth of February, one thousand seven hundred and eighty-nine, entitled, "An act to grant to the corporation of the ministers, vestrymen, and church wardens of the German Lutheran congregation in and near the city of Philadelphia, in the state of Pennsylvania, certain lands therein mentioned, for endowing a free school for the use of the poor of said congregation."

CHAPTER CXXIV.

An ACT fixing the salaries of the officers therein mentioned.

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the salaries of the state treasurer, the secretary of the land office, the surveyor general, and the auditor general, respectively, shall be sixteen hundred dollars a year, to commence the first of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirteen, to be paid quarterly.*
