CHAPTER CXXV.

An ACT enabling a committee appointed by the court of common pleas, of Bucks county, to sell and convey the real estate of Elizabeth Martin, a lunatic.

SECT. I. How proceeds to to the said estate, and after discharging the debts due by the said lunatic, to place the surplus of said lunatic's estate in some productive fund, for her support; provided, that the said John Brown and Joseph Brown, or the survivors of them, shall, before they proceed to sell or convey the aforesaid estate, enter into recognizance with sufficient security to the orphans' court of Bucks county, for the faithful discharge of the trust reposed in them by this act; and that they or either of them, their or his executors or administrators, shall render a true account to the heirs or legal representatives of the said Elizabeth Martin, of the residue, if any shall remain in their hands, at the time of her death, or at the termination of their authority, and that they will pay over the same to such person or persons as shall be legally entitled to receive said surplus.
