CHAPTER CLXXIII.

An ACT for the relief of George Smith of Bedford county, and of Bartholomew Meloy, of Washington county, old soldiers.

40 dollars granted to George Smith, &c.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That if the state treasurer be and he is hereby directed to pay to George Smith, of Bedford county, or order, forty dollars immediately after the passing of this act, and an annuity of forty dollars to be paid half yearly during life, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirteen.

SECT. II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,
