

CHAPTER LXXVII.

An ACT granting relief to Thomas Butts, William Russel, Henry Breneman, and John Gilbert, soldiers.

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the state treasurer be and he is hereby directed to pay unto Thomas Butts of Cumberland county, or his order, the sum of forty dollars, immediately after the passing of this act, and an annuity of forty dollars for life, to be paid half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and fourteen. And that the state treasurer be authorized to pay to William Russel, of Beaver county forty dollars.

Gratuity and annuity of 40 dollars to Thomas Butts.

Forty dollars gratuity to W. Russel.

SECT. II. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the state treasurer be and he is hereby authorized to pay to Henry Breneman, of Westmoreland county, or order, the sum of one hundred dollars, immediately after the passing of this act, out of any money in the treasury.

One hundred dollars to Henry Breneman.

SECT. III. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the state treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized to pay to John Gilbert, of Westmoreland county, or order, the sum of one hundred dollars, immediately after the passing of this act, out of any money in the treasury.

One hundred dollars to J. Gilbert.

CHAPTER LXXVIII.

An ACT authorizing the governor to appoint commissioners to review a road laid out from John Campbell's bridge, in Huntingdon county, by Sinkey's Gap, to intersect the public road in Kishacoquillis valley in Mifflin county.

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the governor be and he is hereby authorized to appoint five commissioners to review that part of a road that lies in Mifflin county, laid out and marked under the provisions of the fourth section of an act of the general assembly, passed the second of April, eighteen hundred and eleven. It shall be necessary that four of the said commissioners shall be on the road the same time, and three of them agreeing shall be sufficient; and the said commissioners shall proceed to perform the said service at
