CHAPTER XVII.

A SUPPLEMENT to the act, entitled “An act to incorporate the Protestant Episcopal church of Saint John, at Yorktown.”

SECT. I. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the election for vestrymen, directed to be held on the fourth day of July, by the tenth section of the act to which this is a supplement, shall annually hereafter be held on Easter Monday, or some day in the same week; any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

CHAPTER XVIII.

An ACT for the election of a constable in the borough of Marietta, in the county of Lancaster.

SECT. I. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the electors residing in the borough of Marietta, in the county of Lancaster, shall, on the third Friday in March, yearly, and every year after the passing of this act, elect two suitable persons, being citizens of said borough, for the office of constable, and shall return the names of the persons so elected to the next court of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace, to be holden for said county, and the said court shall appoint one of them constable for said borough; which constable, when so appointed by the court, may be elected in the borough of Marietta.
