CHAPTER XLVI.

An ACT authorizing certain persons therein named, to raise a gravel bar in the west branch of the river Susquehanna.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Martin Updegraff, Daniel Updegraff and Samuel Updegraff, of the township of Lycoming, in the county of Lycoming, their heirs and assigns, be, and they are hereby authorized to repair the fishery opposite their land, in the west branch of the river Susquehanna, by raising a certain gravel bar (the remains of a former island) in the said river, three feet above its present height, and not exceeding seven perches in length, and five perches in breadth, so as to enable them to draw their seins thereon: Provided, they do not thereby obstruct the navigation of said river, nor interfere with the rights of others.
