CHAPTER LI.

An ACT for the relief of George Parson.

SECT. I. *BE* it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the state treasurer be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to pay to George Parson, or order, the sum of one hundred dollars, in full for a waggon horse, which died of a wound received by a bayonet, while in the service of this state, and attached to the volunteers and militia which marched from Harrisburg to Baltimore in September, one thousand eight hundred and fourteen.

CHAPTER LII.

An ACT declaring part of Broadhead's creek a public highway.

SECT. I. *BE* it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Broadhead's creek, from the mill of John Price, in Pike county, to the mouth of said creek, at Delaware river, in Northampton county, be, and the same is hereby declared a public highway for the

passage of rafts, boats and vessels, and it shall and may be lawful for the inhabitants and others desirous of using the navigation of the said creek, to remove all natural and artificial obstructions which may be in the same, excepting mill dams and other water works, and also to erect such slopes at the mill dams now built in the said creek, as may be necessary for the passage of rafts, boats or other vessels: *Provided* such slopes be so constructed as not to injure the works of said dams: *And provided*, That any person or persons owning or possessing lands on said creek, shall have liberty to construct a dam or dams across the same, agreeably and subject to all the restrictions and provisions of the act of the general assembly of this commonwealth, passed the twenty-third day of March, one thousand eight hundred and three, entitled "An act to authorize any person or persons owning lands adjoining navigable streams of water, declared public highways, to erect dams upon such streams, for mills and other water works."

CHAPTER LIII.

An ACT, for the relief of Jacob Nell.

WHEREAS it appears to the legislature, that Jacob Nell served, as a volunteer, in captain Michael H. Spangler's company, and was shot through the breast at the battle of North Point, near Baltimore, in consequence of which wound he is unable to labour for the support of himself and his family; and it further appears, that he is in indigent circumstances: Therefore,

SECT. I. *BE* it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the state treasurer be, and he is hereby directed to pay to Jacob Nell, of York county, or order, one hundred dollars immediately after the passing of this act, out of any monies in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.
