

CHAPTER LIV.

An ACT for the relief of Andrew M'Dowel and Adam Hill, old soldiers.

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* the state treasurer be, and he is hereby directed to pay to Andrew M'Dowel, of Greene county, or order, forty dollars, immediately after the passing of this act, and an annuity of forty dollars during life, to be paid half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and fifteen, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

SECT. II. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That* the state treasurer be, and he is hereby directed to pay Adam Hill, of Mercer county, or order, forty dollars, immediately after the passing of this act.

CHAPTER LV.

A further SUPPLEMENT to an act, entitled "An act to provide for the erection of houses for the employment and support of the poor in the counties of Chester and Lancaster."

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* the directors of the poor, and of the house of employment of the county of Lancaster, or any four of them, be, and they are hereby authorized, if they deem it expedient, to sell and convey to the manufacturing company of Lancaster, in fee simple, or to exchange with the said company, in fee simple, for other land, any quantity of land belonging and attached to the poor house of the said county: *Provided, That* the same does not exceed three acres.
