gers and others, or who shall wilfully or maliciously obstruct or impede the passage on or over the said bridge, or any part or penalty for parts thereof, he, she or they so offending, shall each of them for-destroying feit and pay for every such offence, to said corporation, the sum of any part of twenty dollars, to be recovered, on conviction, before any justice of said bridge. the peace, as debts of like amount are recoverable; but no suit shall be brought, unless commenced within thirty days after such offence shall have been committed, and he, she or they so offending shall remain liable to actions, at the suit of said corporation, for such wrongs, if the said sum or sums herein mentioned be not sufficient to repair and satisfy said damages: Provided always, That the suit last herein mentioned, shall be brought within thirty days Provise. after such conviction had before any justice of the peace as afore-said, and not otherwise.

## CHAPTER LXXIX.

An ACT to extend the boundaries of Lycoming county.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the first day of May next, the township of Washington, in the county of Union, he, and the same is hereby annexed to the county of Lycoming, and shall be part of the same; and the said township of Washington, in the county of Union, shall be also annexed, for all township purposes, to the township of Washington, in the county of Lycoming, and shall elect with the electors of the said township of Washington, in Lycoming county.
