Provided, That nothing in this act contained, shall, in anywise, Proviso injure or impair the title of any person to the land contained within the said limits or any part thereof.

CHAPTER CII.

An ACT to enable John L. Finney, to transcribe deed book A. in the recorder's office in Northumberland county.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That John L. Finney, recorder of deeds in and for the county of Northumberland, be, and he is hereby authorized to transcribe deed book A. into a new book, which shall be inspected and compared by the commissioners of said county, with the original, and being so compared and certified under their hands and seals, the said John L. Finney shall receive the same fees as is allowed by law for recording of deeds, per line; and the commissioners of said county are hereby authorized and required to draw an order on the treasurer of the said county, in favor of John L. Finney, for the amount of his fees, which the said treasurer is authorized to pay out of any money in his hands.
