## CHAPTER XIV.

A SUPPLEMENT to an act, entitled "An act to enable the Governor to incorporate a company for making an artificial road, beginning at the intersection of the Egypt road with the Ridge turnpike road, two miles above Norristown in the county of Montgomery, from thence to Pawling's ford bridge over the river Schuylkill."

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the time allowed in the seventh section of the act, entitled "An act to enable the governor to incorporate a company for making extended for an artificial road, beginning at the intersection of the Egypt road with the Ridge turnpike road, two miles above Norristown in the county of Montgomery, from thence to Pawling's ford bridge over the river Schuylkill," for beginning the said road, be extended for the term of three years, and the time for completing said road be extended for the term of six years from and after the passing of this act, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

## CHAPTER XV.

An ACT to authorise the purchase of certain copies of Smith's edition of the laws of Pennsylvania.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the secretary of the commonwealth shall purchase, for the use of the commonwealth, two hundred copies of Smith's edition of the Laws of Pennsylvania: Provided, That the price to be paid for the same shall not exceed fourteen dollars per copy, to be paid for at the time of delivery, by warrant drawn on the treasurer in the usual manner.
