CHAPTER XXVIII.

An ACT supplementary to an act, entitled "An act to enable the governor to incorporate a company for making an artificial road from the Spring-house tavern, in Montgomery county, to the borough of Northampton, in the county of Lehigh, and to the town of Bethlehem, in the county of Northampton."

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Spring-house, Northampton town and Bethlehem turnpike Of power to company, shall have power and authority, immediately after the

increase tolls passing of this act, to increase the toll prescribed by the said act for travelling and using the said road, in such proportion as that the said company may be enabled to divide six per centum per annum on the capital stock expended in making the whole of the said road, on which they are or may be from time to time authorised to receive toll, notwithstanding one year may not have expired from the time of completing any such section of the said road, as prescribed in the nineteenth section of the act to which this is a supplement.

Governor to subscribe 200 shares.

Sect. 11. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the governor be, and he is hereby authorised and required to subscribe, on behalf of the commonwealth, for two hundred shares of stock of the said company, and as soon as any section of the said road, not less than five miles, shall be completed and approved, as is directed in and by the said act, the governor is further authorised and required to draw his warwant on the state treasurer in favor of the said company for such part of the amount of stock to be paid by the commonwealth, as shall be in proportion to the whole distance of the said turnpike road, and so from time to time until the whole of the said road shall be completed.

Sect. 111. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That when any section of the said road shall be made, not less than two and an half miles, commencing at the end of the ing commis- first section of the said road already completed, the governor is hereby authorised and required, on notice thereof to him by the said company, to appoint a committee to view the same, and to

proceed in like manner as is directed by the twelfth section of the act to which this is a supplement, and if any such section of two and an half miles shall be approved, to authorise the said company to receive toll thereon in proportion to the distance, any thing in the said twelfth section to the contrary not-
