CHAPTER LXIX.

A SUPPLEMENT to the act, entitled "An act for the appointment and regulation of constables in the township of the Northern Liberties, in the county of Philadelphia."

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this act, the electors of the town-Two addiship of the Northern Liberties shall, on the third Saturday in tional conthe month of March in each and every year, elect four suitable stables to be persons, inhabitants of said township, in addition to the eight appointed for persons to be elected by the act to which this is a supplement, N. Liberties. and return the names of such additional persons so elected, to the next general court of quarter sessions to be held for the county of Philadelphia, and the said court shall appoint two of them constables for said township, and shall also have the same power to appoint another proper person to serve the office of constable for and during the term or residue of the term which the person in whose room he shall be so appointed was entitled to serve, as is given in the act to which this is a supplement.

Sect. 11. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That before either of the said additional constables of said township shall enter on the duties of his office, he shall become bound by recognizance, as is provided for in the act to which Constables to this is a supplement, and the act entitled, "An act to amend give bond. and consolidate with its supplements the act, entitled 'An act for the recovery of debts and demands not exceeding one hundred dollars, before a justice of the peace, and for the election of constables, and for other purposes," passed the twentieth of March, one thousand eight hundred and ten, and shall also be liable to all the restrictions and entitled to all the privileges, emoluments and fees that the present constables of the Northern

Liberties are.

CHAPTER LXX.

A SUPPLEMENT to the act, entitled "An act to incorporate the city of Philadelphia."
