

CHAPTER V.

AN ACT

Authorising Jacob Funk and Jacob Trichler, administrators of John W. Burson, to grant and convey certain real estate.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Jacob Funk and Jacob Trichler, administrators of the estate of John W. Burson, late of Springfield township, in the county of Bucks, deceased, who died intestate, be and they are hereby authorised to make and execute a deed or deeds of conveyance to Nicholas Kramer, of Northampton county, his heirs and assigns, or to such person or persons as he the said Nicholas shall direct, for the one equal undivided half of the following described lots or parcels of land, situate in the township of Springfield and county of Bucks, one beginning at stones in the line of Jacob Fullmer's land, and running thence by the same south, forty degrees, west one hundred and twenty two perches to a post; thence by William Burson's land, north forty degrees, west fifty one perches, thence by the same, north forty three degrees, east sixty two perches, and north forty five degrees, east sixty perches, and south thirty five degrees, east forty perches, to the place of beginning, containing thirty six acres of land, and the other beginning at stones and running thence by land conveyed to Philip Barron, north twenty seven degrees, west seventy one perches to a stake, thence by land of Joseph Affebach, north forty three degrees, east twenty nine perches; thence by the same south forty five degrees, east fifty eight perches to a stake, thence by land of William Burson, south forty three degrees, west eleven perches and six tenths, and south forty degrees, east ten perches, and south forty five degrees, west thirty eight perches to the place of beginning, containing sixteen acres. And all such deed or deeds of conveyance so made by the said administrators or the survivor of them, shall convey the like interest, and have the same force and effect, as though the same had been made by the said John W. Burson in his life time.*
