And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That if the company hereby authorised to be incorporated, shall at any time issue any note or notes in the nature of bank notes, or carry on any business in the nature of banking, then or in either of these cases all and singular the rights, privileges and franchises hereby granted to the said company, shall cease and revert to this Commonwealth.

CHAPTER XXXII.

AN ACT

To authorise the Governor to incorporate a company for improving the navigation of the Lackawana creek.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Noah Stevens, Stephen Griffin, Isaac Hart, John I. Ding and John Waters, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners to do and perform the several things hereinafter mentioned, that is to say, They shall, on or before the first Monday in May next, procure a sufficient number of books, one or more of which shall be opened at some convenient place or places in the township of Pittston and borough of Wilkes-Procure barre, in the county of Luzerne, and in each of them enter books, as follows, "We whose names are hereunto subscribed, do promise to pay to the President and Managers of the Lackawana Navigation Company, the sum of twenty-five dollars Price of for every share of stock in said company set opposite to our shares, respective names, in such manner and proportions, and at such
